Huntington Bank, in partnership with the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference, is offering a scholarship opportunity to recognize outstanding community leadership by a student within the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference. One **\$2,500 scholarship** will be awarded to a deserving recipient in the spring of 2018. Award selection will be based on the student's leadership in community service activities, community service resume, academic grade point average, and the content of a required essay. A committee made up of Ohio Valley Athletic Conference administrators and Huntington Bank representatives will be responsible for determining the recipient of the award. The decision of the judges will be final in all respects.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicant must:

1. Have been involved with community service/volunteer work within the past twelve months.
2. Have an overall undergraduate cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or better based on a maximum 4.0 or the equivalent in other recognized grading systems.
3. Be a student enrolled at an Ohio Valley Athletic Conference member school.
4. Not be a relative of current Huntington Bank or Ohio Valley Athletic Conference employees.
5. Be a U.S. citizen or a permanent resident.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

The documents described below should be assembled and mailed directly to the OVAC office.

1. The application form, to be completed and signed by the student and/or a parent or guardian if under eighteen years of age.
2. The application also includes a community service resume and a brief essay. The essay shall be authored and signed by the applicant. If under the age of eighteen, the essay will need to be authorized and signed by the student's parent or guardian.
3. A current official transcript.
4. One (1) letter of recommendation from volunteer supervisor, teacher, counselor, coach, or employer.
5. Complete application package **MUST BE RECEIVED by APRIL 2, 2018.**

SCHOLARSHIP PRESENTATION AND ADDITIONAL DETAILS:

1. The scholarship will be awarded at the OVAC Banquet of Champions, held at WesBanco Arena, on Monday, May 14, 2018.
2. The scholarship can be applied to a technical school, two-year community college, or four-year college or university. The scholarship will be made payable to the institution of the awardee's choice.

 - F. Mail all of the materials together in one envelope
5. Be sure the postmark is visible. Overnight mail is not necessary if the postmark deadline is met.

Only applications received by April 2, 2018, will be considered.
