1) You Deserve it Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: December 29, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Territory: You must be a resident of any of the 50 United States, District of Columbia or US Territories
- B) Age: You must be 16 years of age or older

2) Illustrators of the Future Scholarship - \$5,000 - 4 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be new or amateur artists who have not been professionally published and paid for more than three black-and-white story illustrations, or more than one process-color painting or have your work broadly featured to the general public through the media.

3) HP Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: December 31, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) A legal resident of the 50 United States and DC who are:
- B) 13 years or older at the time of entry,

4) Stephen J. Brady Stop Hunger Scholarships - \$5,000 - 5 Awards (Deadline: December 5, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be enrolled in an accredited educational institution (kindergarten through graduate school) in the United States. All applicants must be ages 5-25.

B) Have demonstrated on-going commitment to their community by performing unpaid volunteer services impacting hunger in the United States within the last 12 months.

5) AXA Achievement Scholarships - \$25,000 - 52 Awards (Deadline: December 15, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be United States citizens or legal residents living or claiming residency in one of the 50 United States, Washington, D.C. or Puerto Rico

B) Be current high school seniors who plan to enroll full-time in an accredited two-year or four-year college

6) Easton / NFAA Scholarship Program - \$5,000 - 5 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) High school applicants must be applying to be full time students at a two or four-year college/university or a technical training college.

7) Harris Poll Scholarship - \$1,000 – 1 Award (Deadline: December 31, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) A legal resident of the 50 United States and DC who are:

B) 13 years or older at the time of entry,

8) Thiel Fellowship - \$100,000 - 30 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be interested in building new things. Founded by technology entrepreneur and investor Peter Thiel in 2011.

The Thiel Fellowship is a two-year program that offers 20-30 fellowships in the value of \$100,000 over a two year period.

9) VIP Scholarship - \$5,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: January 31, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be at least 13 years of age or older.

B) Submit your entry by 11:59 pm ET on the day of the deadline.

10) Union Plus Scholarship - \$4,000 - 100 Awards (Deadline: January 31, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Current and retired members of participating unions, their spouses and their dependent children (as defined by IRS regulations).

B) At least one year of continuous union membership by the applicant, applicant's spouse or parent (if applicant is a dependent).

4) SP Scholarships - \$10,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school student planning to attend college in September 2018
- B) Answer the Essay question on the sponsors website.

5) CrossLites Scholarship - \$4,000 - 27 Awards (Deadline: December 31, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- B) There are no minimum GPA or test score requirements in order to qualify for the scholarship contest.

6) VIP Voice Scholarship - \$5,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: December 31, 2017)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- B) Submit your entry by 11:59 pm ET on the day of the deadline.
- C) You can submit multiple entries by following the instructions on the sponsors website.

7) Profile in Courage Scholarship - \$10,000 – 7 Awards (Deadline: January 4, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a United States high school student in grades nine through twelve
- B) Be attending public, private, parochial, or home schools and be under the age of twenty.

8) Ron Brown Scholarships Program - \$40,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: January 9, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be U.S. citizens or permanent residents, Black/African American and current high school seniors at the time of their application.
- B) Demonstrate academic achievement, exhibit leadership ability, participate in community service activities and have a demonstrated financial need.

9) Washington Crossing Foundation Scholarship - \$5,000 - 5 Awards (Deadline: January 15, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior who is a US citizen.
- B) Be planning a career of service to the United States in local, state, or federal government.
