A brief but important reminder here concerning the Monongalia County school calendar for the next few weeks.

Staff and students will resume our county's Blended and Distance Learning models this Monday, Dec. 7, and will continue that schedule through Monday, Dec. 21.

Blended Learning students will not report to their schools Tuesday and Wednesday, Dec. 22 and 23, but will join Distance learners for two days of non-traditional, on-line instruction.

Instruction will be suspended during our winter holiday Thursday, Dec. 24, through Friday, Jan. 1. We anticipate returning to our current Blended and Distance Learning models Monday, Jan. 4, 2021.

As has been the case since mid-March 2020, our primary objectives during the ongoing Coronavirus pandemic are to keep our students and staff as safe as is practicable and to provide our students with the highest quality instruction possible. Working with the Mon County Health Department and the Centers for Disease Control, we continue to closely monitor local, regional and state trends in COVID-19 incidence and to collaborate with those organizations to minimize the virus' impact in our schools.

As we work toward our well-earned winter break, I encourage all students' parents to continue to be vigilant about completing their students' daily health self-report on the MCS Web site and/or app. And please, please encourage your students to continue social distancing, frequent handwashing and masking up.
