Welcome to the resumption of Mon County Schools' 2018-2019 academic year.

MCS administrators were apprised last week of a potential "walk-in" by school service and professional staff Jan. 9, 2019 – this Wednesday – at schools throughout the state. The intent of this effort, which coincides with the opening day of the West Virginia Legislature's 2019 regular session, is to inform the public of compensation- and benefits-related issues of school personnel and other state employees.

The anticipated walk-in will be conducted by professional and service staff at various school sites during the 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the standard instructional day. It will not impact or impede students' arrival for a regular day of instruction.

Please know that the Monongalia Board of Education and its administration continue to support equitable compensation for all school employees – compensation that allows West Virginia to recruit and retain qualified professional and service staff in an increasingly competitive employment environment.
